What is Absentee Voting?

- This allows you to vote by mail or vote early in person. You must fill out an application for a ballot and send it to the county election office.
- In the application you must provide a driver's license or the last 4 digits of your social security number
- You DO need an excuse to request an absentee ballot. Attending university in another state is an excuse!

a photo ID (such as university/college photo ID) AND proof of residence (such as university bank statement or utility bill)
