Important Dates

General Election: November 6, 2018

Voter Registration Deadline: October 15, 2018

Request for Absentee Ballot: October 30, 2018 by mail,
November 3, 2018 by 5pm in person

How many ways can I pre-register?



- **Online:** <https://turbovote.org/> OR <https://www.elections.virginia.gov/citizen-portal/index.html>
- You will need to provide your Social Security Number.
- **In Person & By Mail:** This must be sent and received by your local Board of Elections office 22 days before the election.

What is a voter information card?

- The card will have your party affiliation, assigned polling location, and local, state, and federal district designation.
- Check your card on election day to ensure you arrive at the correct polling location
- This card is a valid form of ID on Election Day

Where can I vote on Election Day?

What is Absentee Voting/ Voting by Mail?

- This allows you to vote by mail if you cannot vote in person on election day.
- You can request a vote-by mail ballot online at <https://vote.elections.virginia.gov/VoterInformation>
- You can complete and return this form to your local Board of Elections to receive a ballot by mail or visit your local Board of Elections office to complete the form.

Election Day!

What to bring:

Due to Virginia's new voter law, all voters must provide one valid form of ID on Election Day.

- EX: Voter Registration Card, Virginia driver's license or ID card, student photo ID from a Virginia higher education institution, US passport, etc.
- If you don't have ID on you, don't worry! You can submit a provisional ballot and provide ID later.
